Exporting Your Audio for Mastering

Before we can master your audio, we need you to send us the audio portion of your edit session. This is done by exporting an OMF file. Please use the following steps. Note that some options may be located differently depending on your software.

- Open your session
- Select File > Export > OMF
- In the OMF Export Settings dialog box, type a title for the OMF file into the OMF Title field. Make sure it contains the title of your project.
- From the Sample Rate and Bits Per Sample menus, choose the settings needed for your project. Ideally, these should be the same settings with which you originally recorded the audio during production.
- From the files menu, select Encapsulate. It may also be labelled Embedded Audio
- From the Render menu, choose Copy Complete Audio File. It may also be called Render Complete Audio Files.
- Save/Export OMF
- Send to Tyton Sound. We can accept hard drives, flash drives, or via file sharing sites such as Dropbox.
