Exporting Your Audio for Mastering

Before we can master your audio, we need you to send us the audio portion of your edit session. This is done by exporting an AAF file. Please use the following steps. Note that some options may be located differently depending on your software.

- Open your session
- Select File > Export > AAF
- In the AAF Export Settings dialog box
 - Make sure the sample and bit rates match those of your project.
 - Select Imbed Audio.
 - Under Render, select Trim Audio Files.
 - Set Handle Frames to 300.
 - Click OK.
- An AAF will typically be a very large file. Depending on its size you may want to send the export via a file sharing platform like Google Drive, WeTransfer, or Dropbox. Otherwise, a physical drive may be sent.
- If AAF is not available to you, you may be able to execute a similar process with an OMF.
